

Miss Rodeo Okotoks - "PRINCESS FOR A DAY" Contest

The Miss Rodeo Okotoks "PRINCESS FOR A DAY" contest is open to girls between the ages of 8-12. The winner will have the opportunity to travel and participate in events with Miss Rodeo Okotoks on Saturday September 4, 2010. The purpose of this contest is to give young girls an opportunity to see what it's like to be a rodeo queen.

The "Princess for a Day" will travel with Miss Rodeo Okotoks, the visiting rodeo royalty, and chaperones to events around Okotoks. These could include a pancake breakfast, visiting Miss Rodeo Okotoks sponsors, a royal lunch, the Miss Rodeo Okotoks Alumni Magic Rodeo, downtown Okotoks events, and the evening performance of the Okotoks Pro Rodeo.

"Princess for a Day" Rules & Guidelines

1. Applicants must be between the ages of 8-12.
2. Applicants do not need any previous experience with rodeo or horses.
3. Applications must be received by NO LATER than noon on August 6, 2010 for the application to be considered.
4. Only the winner will be contacted by phone on or before August 20.
5. Applicants must be from the Okotoks area.
6. In order for the winner to participate the release waiver must be signed by the parent/guardian before September 4, 2010.
7. The application form must be filled out entirely for it to be considered.
8. If the participant has a medical condition, a parent or guardian must accompany the child throughout the day.

9. If the participant does not have a medical condition a parent/guardian is not required to accompany their child, but must remain within 20 minutes of Okotoks and be readily available if needed.
10. If required, ONE parent/guardian will be allowed to accompany the participant. Space in the official Miss Rodeo Okotoks vehicle is limited.
11. The participant will be required to wear appropriate clothing consisting of pants (jeans preferred), a "fancy" shirt, and appropriate footwear (no sandals or open toed shoes).
12. Inappropriate behavior could result in the child being sent home from the event.
13. If the participant selected is not able to participate, a new applicant will be chosen.
14. The winner will be sent an itinerary for the day. All meals will be included.
15. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to inform the chaperones of any allergies, medications, etc.
16. The participant chosen as "Princess for a Day" will have her picture taken, name used, and be introduced at public events during the day.
17. The participant will be around animals and in the rodeo arena.
18. Opportunities may vary from year to year. A winner should not expect the same opportunities as winners from previous years.
